JEAN CLARKE OBIT

Jean Clarke 1935-2021, Senator number 49416, Life Member 60, a true Arizona girl was born in Clifton, AZ. She moved to Phoenix and met Ted in 1951. They married in 1952 and moved to Tempe where they both joined the Tempe Jaycees, Jean as a member and later an officer of the "Jayshees", women's auxiliary.

Jean was involved in many if not all of the chapter's projects, always helping Ted, including Jr. Miss, haunted houses, annual barbeques and ASU parking just to name a few. She was an accomplished seamstress, making membership vests, bunny costumes for the Easter egg hunt and personally running the Clothes for Boys & Girls Club project. Along the way they had and raised four children, Debbie, Donna, Ted Jr. and Rickey. They moved to Strawberry in 1989 and remained very active in the AZJCI Senate, hosting board meetings and long weekend planning sessions with a dozen or more members sleeping over. In the morning, Jean would cook a HUGE breakfast with gallons of coffee to cure the effects of latenight card games and the beer. After 23 years in Strawberry, they moved to Mesa. On the evening of January 14th Jean's family gathered around her and were led by a minister in a prayerful moment. When it was over, they all said "amen" Jean stopped breathing and was peacefully gone.

Bruce Michael Birnbaum (1943 - 2020) #39828 LM #015 (Ahwatukee '86)

Past President of the AZ JCI Senate (1992-93), Bruce Michael Birnbaum,77, passed away on November 17, 2020, after refusing to live in a world where Penn State doesn't have a winning football team. The doctors claim that COVID-19 got him, but his family knows that the true cause was the Nittany Lions 0-4 start. Bruce was born in New York City in 1943, and grew up in River Edge, NJ, with

brother, Alan, and sister, Carol. He graduated from Pennsylvania State University in 1965. Bruce and his wife, Marcy, were married for 55 years.

Bruce loved clever, off-color humor particularly from the likes of Don Rickles who once picked apart Bruce at a live show. After being valedictorian of his high school class, Bruce worked for the CIA, IBM, Security Pacific Bank, City of Mesa, and Cambridge Technology Partners.

Bruce and I, Mike Schmitt #39725 LM #42, were good friends. He was a member of the Ahwatukee Jaycees and Phoenix Jaycees. We worked together on publicity for the 1982 National Jaycees Convention in Phoenix. In May 1992, Bruce told me that he would run for Senate president if I would be the secretary/treasurer (The jobs were combined then.). I said "yes" and he was elected the Senate's 1992-93 president and I secretary/treasurer.

Sometime in the mid-1990's on a Saturday morning, Bruce rode with me in my red GMC pickup truck to Yuma for a Senate meeting. While there, Bill Buck ribbed me about just coming for the meeting and not staying overnight like him. Then about an hour later, Bill changed his mind and asked to drive back to Phoenix with Bruce and me. Actually, we three wide-bodies fit comfortably on the truck's big bench seat. Then about 50 miles into the dark desert, Bill groaned that his Mexican food and margarita lunch was doing a number on his stomach and that he was in distress. I threatened Bill that he'd have to sit in the

bed of the pickup if he had an accident. Luckily, sometime later we found a service station for Bill and then continued uneventfully to Phoenix.
