Life Member Fund News:

Sadly, two Life Members of the Arizona JCI Senate passed away recently:

John R. Bickert, JCI #10991, AZ Life Member #18, who lived in Tempe died last December 27th. John received his Senatorship from the Lansing, Michigan, Jaycees in 1970.

Rollie E. Thornton, JCI #40179, AZ Life Member #19, passed away on November 11, 2019. Rollie was 80 years old and lived in Medford, OR, for many years. He received his Senatorship from the Yuma Jaycees in 1986. Rollie and his wife, Karin, were married for almost 57 years. (See obituary below).

LIFE MEMBER PASSING Rollie E. Thornton (1939 – 2019)

Rollie Thornton arrived in Yuma, AZ, in November 1962, as a member of the U.S. Navy, stationed at Marine Corps Aviation Station Yuma. In

March 1963, Rollie went on a blind date that would change and enhance his life forever. He met Karin Smith, and in just a few months, they were married on July 13, 1963. Their lives together focused on family, friends and giving back to their community.

Rollie had been a member of the Jaycees since 1963. He won many awards such as the Silver Spur and Jaycee of the Year. In 1978, he was Rodeo Parade Chairman, in 1979, Rodeo Vice Chairman and in 1980, Rodeo Chairman.

Rollie retired from the U.S. Navy in 1976. He later went to work for a Coors Distributor, the Yuma County Adult Detention Facility, the U.S. Marshall Service and Motel 6. Rollie and Karin have two children, five grandchildren and five great grandsons. Although, they moved to Medford, Oregon, in 2007, to be close to their family, Yuma, and its extended Jaycee family, always remained close to their hearts.
